# NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON E-CONTENT DEVELOPMENT FOR ENHANCING PEDAGOGICAL SKILLS FOR TEACHERS IN HIGHER EDUCATION: A COMPLETE E-CONTENT PRODUCTION EXPERIENCE

We are pleased to inform you that the Centre for Education Beyond Curriculum (CEDBEC), Christ University, Bangalore is organizing a National Workshop on "e-Content Development for Enhancing Pedagogical Skills for Teachers in higher Education" on 9 - 11 September 2014.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Indian Higher education is heading towards more improved pedagogical means to engage learners in interesting and authentic contexts. The impact is felt with the knowledge explosion and with rapid developments in information technology. For those involved in teaching it becomes a big challenge to cope with curricular transactions. Only a vigilant learner/teacher can survive in this digital age. Innovative ICT methods accompanied by a reformed pedagogy will enhance the interest and involvement of the student in dialogic learner-centred approaches. When e-learning is reshaping the educational landscape of the world, the essential condition for effective practices of digital age pedagogy is that there must

be access to high quality, culturally relevant content in digital forms. And that should be totally applicable to all disciplines irrespective of the domains. In this background, as a sequel to the workshop 'e-Content Development of Indigenous Teaching Practices in Humanities and Social Sciences' organized in May 2014, CEDBEC is organizing another workshop on "e-Content Development for enhancing Pedagogical Skills for teachers in Higher Education". The workshop will be a training-cum-production type involving lecture-cum-demonstrations, interactive sessions and hands-on practice. This will also include e-content scripting, script finalization for the e-content, preparation of audio and video components. The participants will go through a complete pre-production, production, post production video shoot and studio experience.

Since the workshop timings will extend well beyond the office hours, it has been planned as a residential one. It has been planned in such a way that every participant will carry home their e-content as an outcome of the workshop.

#### **GOAL OF THE WORKSHOP**

The goal of the workshop is to enable the participants to understand the need and significance of e-content in the context of Indian education, to know the dynamics of e-content creation and to produce a sample e-content in the form of Short Learning Object (SLO). Further they will acquire the skills and knowledge of the craft into the different aspects of designing online content for learning, to organize content to respond to the appeal which learners like to engage with the changes in technology that support their mindset for effective learning.
