# **Duration of the Programme at BCU**

Semester 1 begins at the end of September of the same year There is a 4 week break at the end of December/beginning of January Semester 2 begins at the end of January and ends in May

#### Eligibility Criteria to Transfer to BCU, UK

Successful completion of two years of BA (JPEng/CEP) programme with overall aggregate of 60% (first four semesters) and pass in all examined modules. Students will also need a minimum score of 6.5 in IELTS or equivalent TOEFL/Pearson test.

Students joining the third year of the BA (Hons) Media and Communication at BCU will be expected to undertake a number of pieces of work before coming to Birmingham to help prepare them for assessments.

Students should have undertaken modules in two production areas – journalism, radio, TV, PR, photography etc.

#### Cost in BCU, UK for One Year

Tuition Fees: £9,900 (Students applying directly to BCU who have an IELTS score of 6.5 or above will be entitled to a £1,000 scholarship; those applying directly and with an IELTS score of 7.0 or above will be awarded £2,000) Living Cost: Approx £7,000 (Food & Accommodation)

## **Progression to Masters Programme**
