They have to include their names, addresses and contact information including their E-mail addresses and phone numbers.

Participants need to enclose a bona fide certificate from the Principal or the Head of the Institution/ College/University along with the copy of the college Identity Card.

There is no limit to the number of entries from a single college or institution.

All entries should be original with appropriate references. Plagiarised entries will be disqualified

EVALUATION PROCESS AND REWARDS

The entries will be evaluated by an eminent panel of judges and the authors of ten best entries will be invited to Christ University to make a presentation and to defend their ideas in the presence of over

one thousand students of Humanities and Social Sciences
