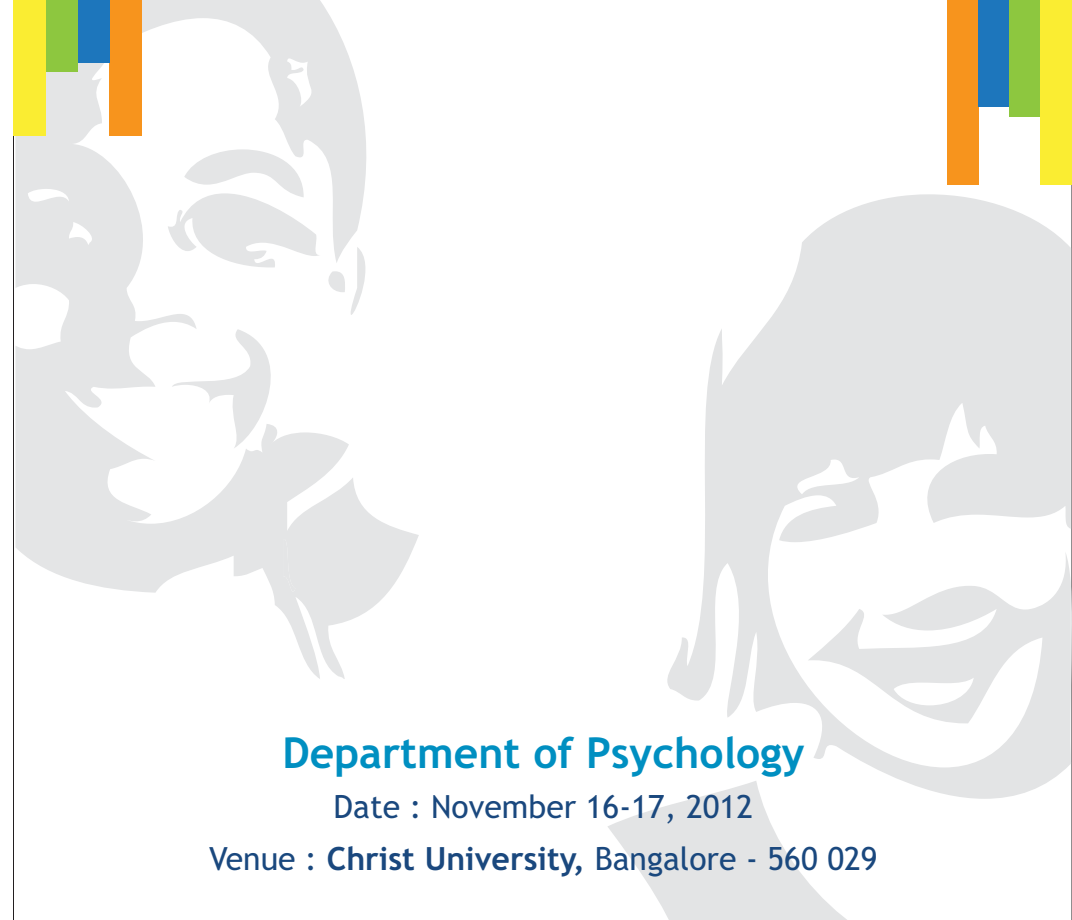

- Explore new methods and techniques that can be applied to develop creative skills in different subject domains.

The workshop will consist of multiple components that will be arranged to engage the interest of the participants. Each session will have a facilitator who will use both instructional and experiential methods to enable the participants to meet the objectives of the workshop. The resource persons for the workshop will be the faculty of the Department of Psychology who will bring their rich expertise and experiences to facilitate learning.
