## ABOUT CHRIST UNIVERSITY

Christ University formerly Christ College (Autonomous) was founded in 1969 by the religious community, the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI). Christ College was the first educational institution in South India to be awarded an A+ by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), an independent Council under the University Grants Commission (UGC). The UGC has recognized Christ College as an institution with Potential for Excellence. Christ College was declared Deemed to be University in July 2008, under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956.

Christ University, a premier educational institution, is an academic fraternity of individuals dedicated to provide excellence and service.

## SCHOOL OF LAW

Christ College of Law was started in the year 2006 under the Bangalore University, which later became the School of Law under Christ University, from 2008 onwards.

At the School of Law, knowledge is imparted by a teaching - learning process; teaching is supplemented by a variety of skills, such as legal writing, research, skills in advocacy and management of time. Students are encouraged to pursue research and publish their papers in leading journals.

In addition to the mandatory courses over the ten semester program, the School of Law, Christ University has introduced for the benefit of its students, numerous other value-added courses and programs aimed at placing students on par with standards of legal education imparted at the best international universities.

The courses are specifically designed keeping in mind the latest developments in the field of law. The course is oriented towards the industry and is guided by an advisory board which comprises of some of the leading lights from the legal fraternity.

The School of Law library has over 12000 books and 6000 reports. It has access to 45 journals, and 8 online resources - Manupatra, Westlaw, Hein Online, JSTOR, SCC Online, LexisNexis and EBSCO.
